



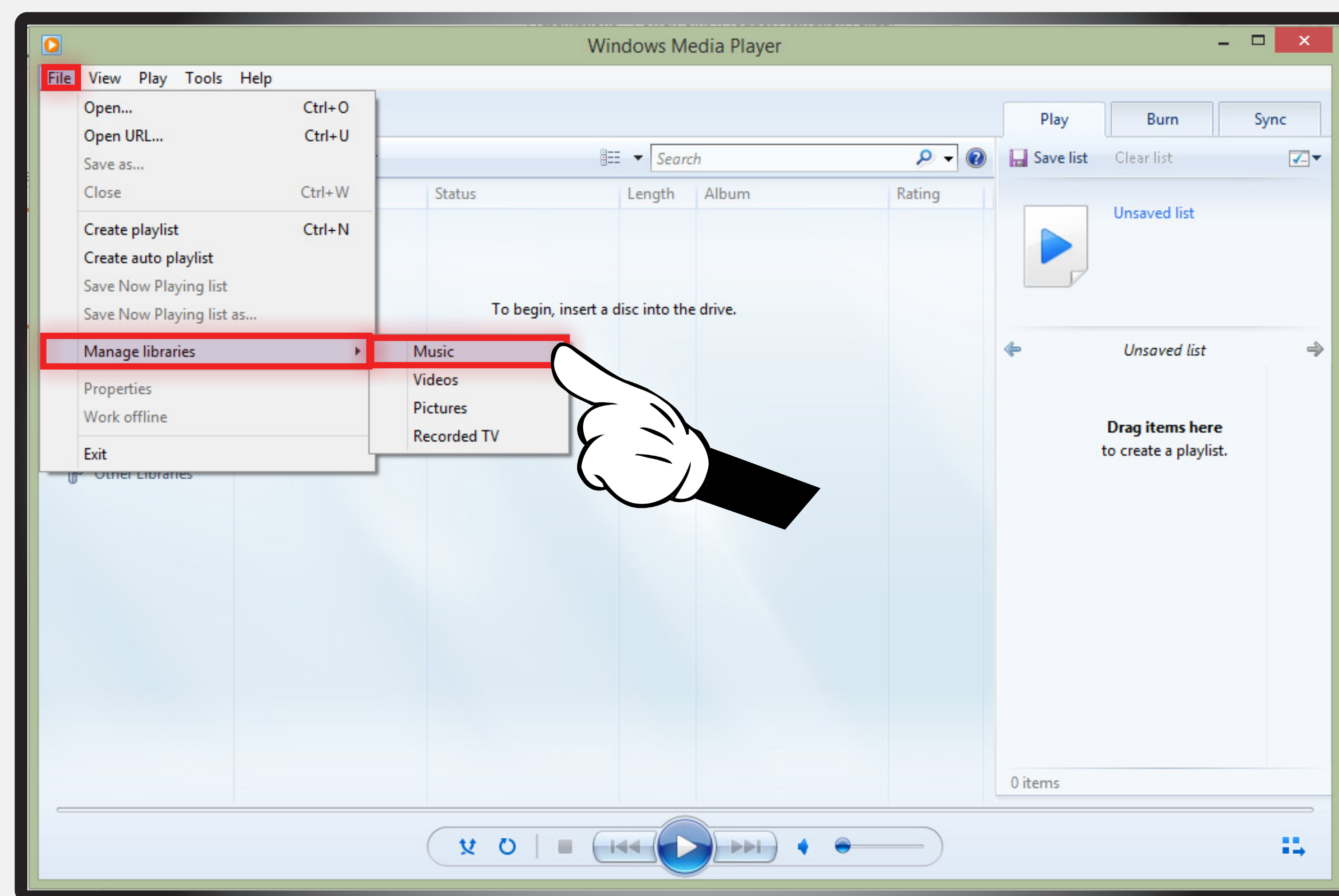
Adding Music to my Windows Media Player Library

(Windows Media optimized)

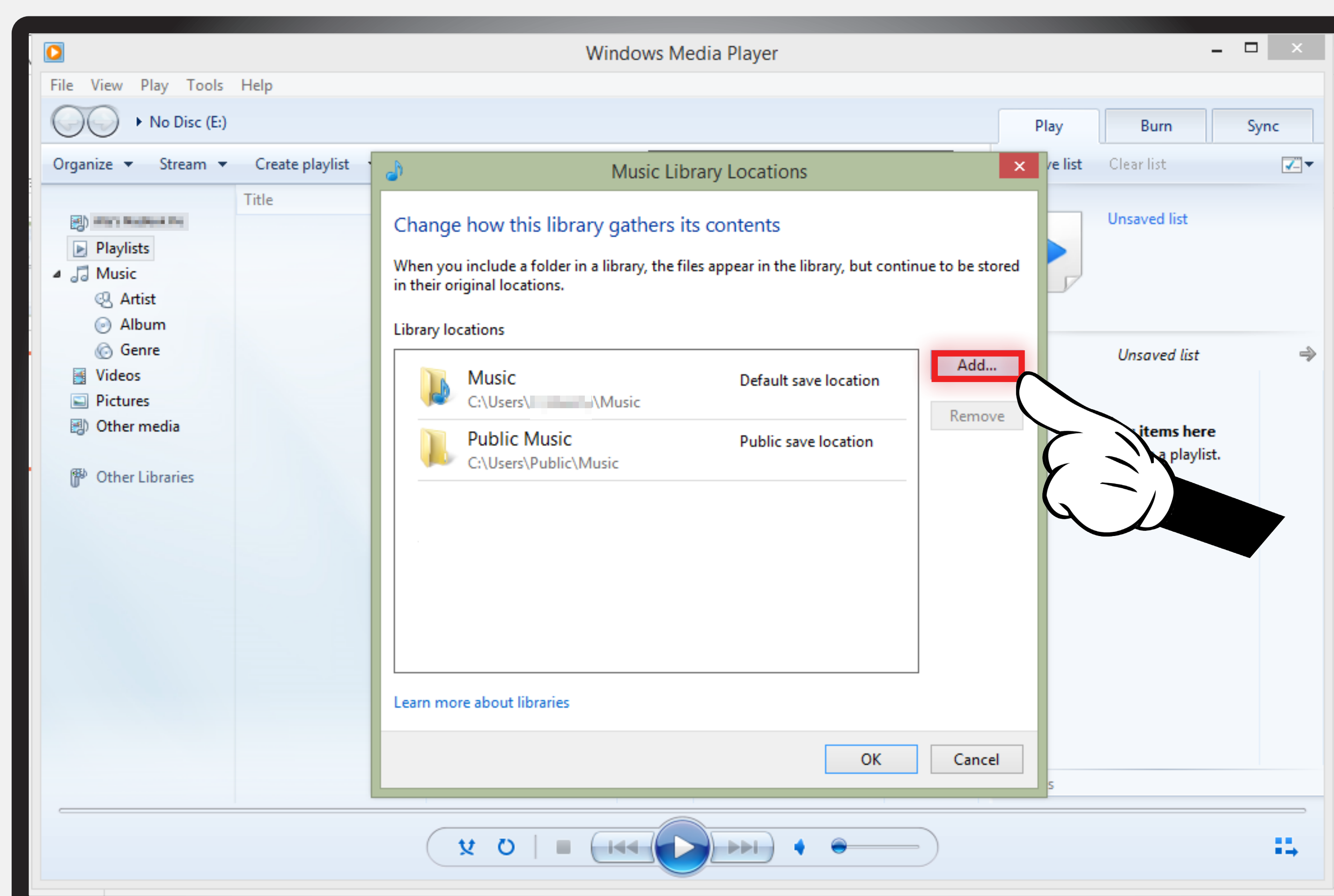
Follow these step-by-step instructions:

Step 1: Locate and launch Windows Media Player.

Step 2: Click “File” on menu bar. From the drop down menu select “Manage Libraries,” then select “Music” from sub-menu.



Step 3: In the “Music Library Locations” window click “Add.”

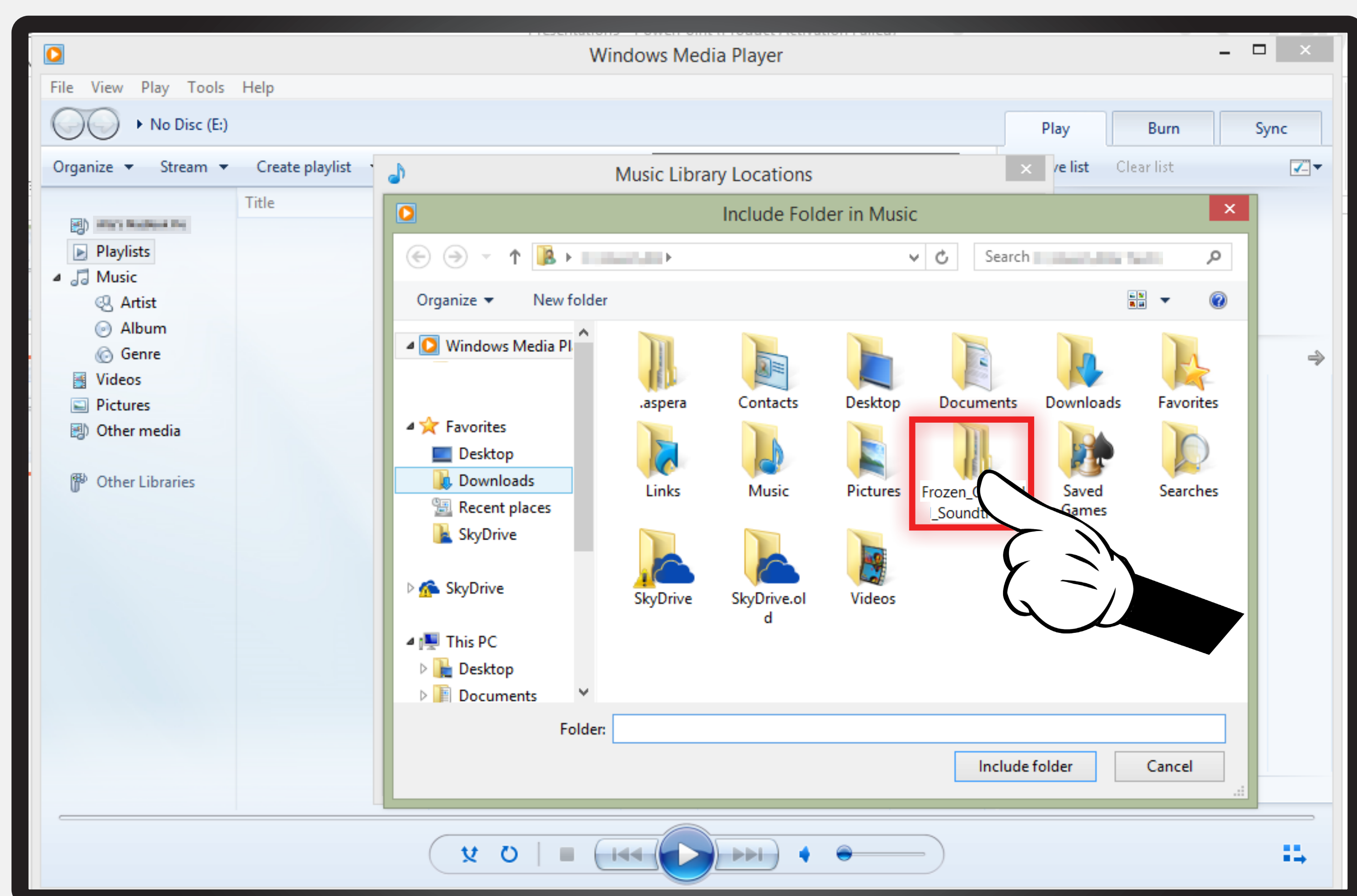




Step 4: In the “Include Folder in Music” window select “Downloads.”

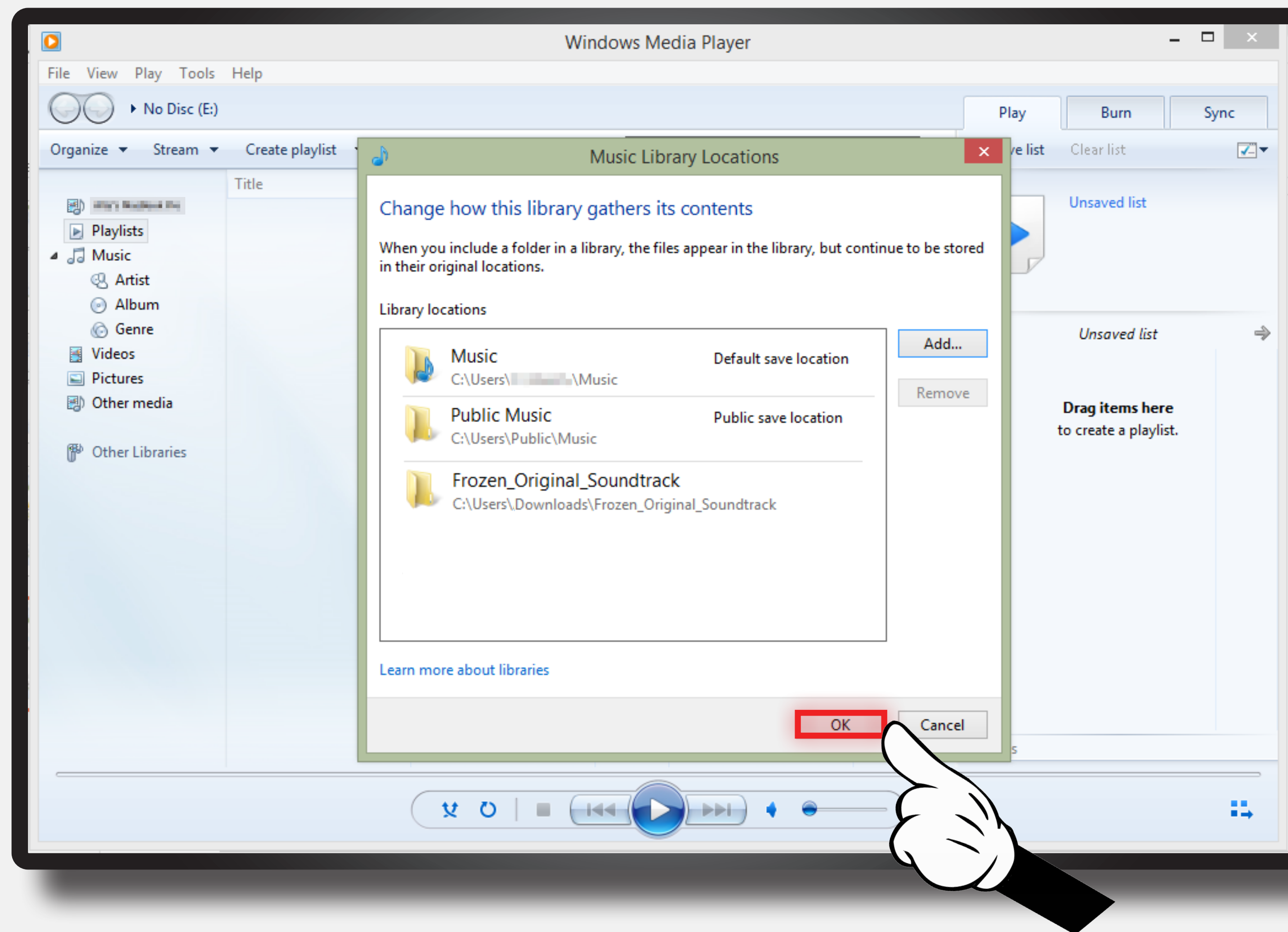


Step 5: Find and Select the folder you wish to add to your music library.

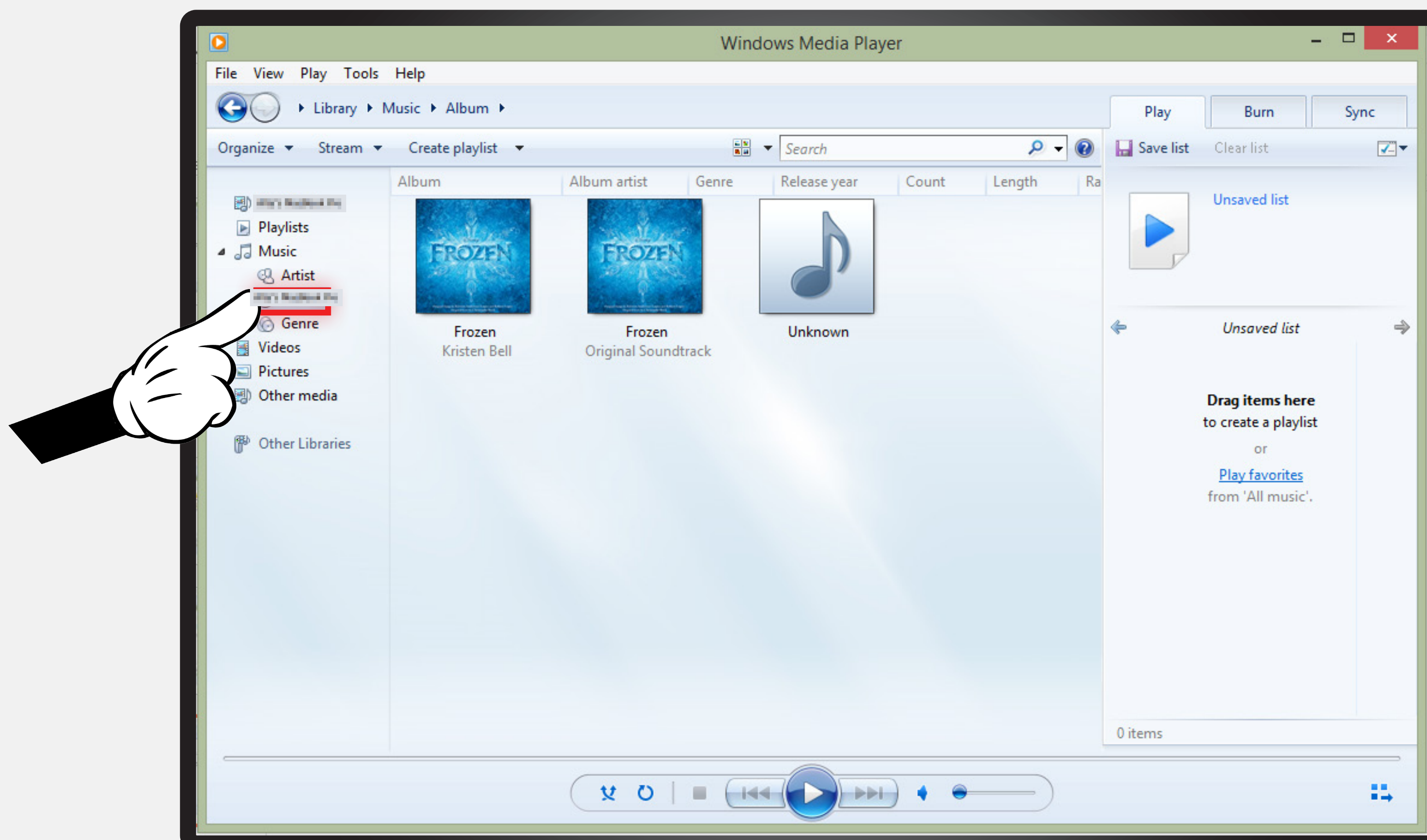




Step 6: Click “OK” at the bottom of the screen.



Step 7: Select “Album” on the left navigation, then select on the album icon (e.g. Frozen) to view your music files.





Step 8: Your downloaded music is now available in Windows Media Player.
